Call for Abstracts

Abstracts will be accepted for following three technical sessions:

- 1. **Biological Sciences (BS)** and all sub-disciplines, including but not limited to Health Sciences, Agricultural Sciences, Botany, Zoology, Biochemistry, Microbiology, Environmental Sciences, Biotechnology, Bioinformatics
- Natural Sciences (NS) and all sub-disciplines, including but not limited to Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Geology, Engineering, Computer Sciences, Information Technology
- 3. **Social Sciences (SS)** and all sub-disciplines, including but not limited to Economics, Business Administration, Linguistics, Anthropology, Sociology, Journalism, History and Pakistan Studies

Each technical session will comprise of a plenary lecture (invited speaker) and speakers selected from the abstracts. All other submissions will be accepted for poster presentations. All abstracts will be reviewed by the organizing committee / experts in each field.
